2. When was the last time you were visited by someone in the congregation?
 - a. If you received a visit, what did you appreciate most?
 - b. If you have never been visited, what disappoints you most?
3. How well is your congregation organized to make certain everyone is visited by someone?
 - a. If not well organized, what can you do to implement organization so that the workload is divided and you can be assured that everyone is getting visited?
 - b. How can you improve training people who make visits?
 - c. How does your church provide for pairs to visit when working with a person of the opposite sex?
4. Who visits the pastor and his family? other professional church workers and their families?
 - a. If you don't know, whom can you ask?
 - b. If no one is making home visits to them, what can you do to change that?
5. What resources are available for you as leaders to lead a devotion?
