Demonstration Role Play 3: Apply Scripture (Case #1 page 98)

Be prepared to answer these questions in a poll or chat box after the demonstration:

- *Poll (True or False):*
 - o The coach argued with Kyle.
 - o The coach read a Bible passage to show Kyle he was wrong.
 - The coach patiently listened to each of Kyle's answers as he repeated his blameshifting.
 - o The coach asked Kyle to read a Bible passage and apply it to himself.
 - The coach explained how the passage fit Kyle's situation.
 - The coach used silence to allow Kyle to reflect on how to apply the Bible passage to his own situation.
- What made the coach's silence so effective?
- How did the coach provide comfort and hope to Kyle?

Participant Role Play 3: Apply Scripture (Case #2 page 100)

Instructions:

- You will be placed into rooms in pairs, one <u>coach</u> and one <u>party</u>
- First, determine who is coach and who is the party
- Coach role plays him/herself, as a party, men role play Robert while women role play Emily
- Coach, practice drawing out the story with questions while parties respond to questions
- You'll have 12 minutes for this exercise.
- You have 12 minutes for this exercise; 9 minutes for role play and 3 minutes for feedback
 - You will receive broadcast message to stop the role play & start the feedback
 - Coach: What I did well was ... / One thing I'd do different is ...
 - Party: What I though you did well was ... / One suggestion I have is ...
 - o A one-minute timer will be presented 60 seconds before you are brought back to main room

Be prepared to answer these questions in the chat box or a poll after the role play:

- Poll: How comfortable are you finding an appropriate scripture passage? (1: Comfortable, 5: Ill-equipped)
- Poll: When scripture was utilized, were they passages of <u>Law</u> or <u>Gospel</u>, or both?
- Poll: When scripture was utilized, did the coach read, or the party, or both?
- Poll: When the party recognized their sin, did the coach proclaim God's forgiveness?

Video: King David's Servants

Be prepared to answer these questions in small group discussion after the video:

- What actions did David take to conceal his sins?
- How does Proverbs 28:13 address our attempts to cover up our sins?
- What other sins did David commit?
- What did David's sins reveal about his idols?
- What was David willing to sacrifice in order to serve his idols?
- How is David's slide into these sins similar to our own struggle?



Self-Examination Exercise (page 47)

Instructions:

- Think of a specific conflict . . .
- Identify the idol(s)
 - Improper desires for physical pleasure
 - Pride and arrogance
 - Love of money or material possessions
 - Fear of man
 - Good things that I wanted too much
- What or whom I sacrificed or executed
- What will be the end result if idolatry remains unchecked?
